



# Parking and Traffic Control Survey

## Ferndale Road Malvern Road Montague Road

One of the issues raised at the FARA AGM in May was the difficulty in finding **parking spaces** and **increased congestion** in Ferndale Road, Malvern Road and the upper end of Montague Road.

Concern was raised that there are often no parking spaces available at all particularly in the mornings, meaning residents have to park much further away from their homes, causing difficulties especially for those with small children, mobility issues or carrying heavy shopping.

The streets north of Ferndale Road are part of a large Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) covering Leytonstone town centre. However in previous Council consultations (most recently in 2012) residents in Ferndale, Malvern and Montague Roads voted against being part of a CPZ scheme.

FARA remains neutral on the introduction of a CPZ scheme as we are aware that residents' views are divided on parking controls. Some residents would like another vote due to growing pressure on our streets from commuters, businesses, garages, schools and possible impact from new developments such as the Lincolns site. Other residents do not see parking as a big problem, feel it would be inconvenient for themselves and their visitors, or don't want to have to pay to park on their road. **We are carrying out this survey to gather opinions in our area.** If the majority of residents are now in favour of a CPZ scheme we will ask the Council to carry out a formal consultation. We also want to gain views on whether there is support for traffic control measures in our area in view of congestion, speeding and risk of accidents particularly around the junctions of Ferndale Road and Malvern / Montague Roads. A one way system around Ferndale, Malvern and the upper end of Montague Road has been suggested but we welcome your suggestions for other ideas.
